

While there exists a legal provision for brain death, institutional protocols

for diagnosis are not universal and are often absent; no specific criteria for diagnosis is mandated. The Brain Death Determination Certification Course aims to standardize the process of brain death diagnosis. This credentialing tool will help those clinicians — who are allowed by their local laws to perform brain death determination — learn and demonstrate their level of understanding and expertise. **Up to 2 CE**
