# **Overview of the Neurocritical Care Society**

- <u>Background</u>
  - The Neurocritical Care Society is the only professional society representing multidisciplinary teams of providers who care for patients with life threatening neurologic injuries. The society is comprised of physicians, nurses, pharmacists, advanced practice providers, researchers and scientists. NCS promotes and fosters research through the Neurocritical Care Research Network (NCRN) and serves the needs of the profession through practice guidelines, certification courses, an international annual meeting, and online education materials and publications
- Brief History/Milestones:
  - The Neurocritical Care Society was founded in 2002 and became a multidisciplinary society in 2004. The society has grown steadily since its founding and now has over 2,700 members internationally with annual meeting attendance exceeding 1,000 members
    - Key milestones:
      - Neurocritical Care (NCC) journal published its first issue in 2004 and exceed usage of > 170,000 annually in 2012
      - First NCS guidelines published in 2012 (Status Epilepticus)
      - The NCRN was founded in 2010 (currently has 163 sites in 47 countries)
      - The Emergency Neurological Life Support (ENLS) was launched in 2012 and reached 10,000 certificants in 2017
- <u>NCS Leadership/Structure:</u>
  - NCS has 5 executive officers and a 8 member executive committee
  - $\circ$  NCS has 13 committees that are comprised of volunteer members of NCS
  - NCS has 20+ sections for member involvement; each section has a resource/discussion page on the NCS website
- Involvement in NCS
  - Pharmacy Section members are highly encouraged to become involved in NCS through committee involvement, annual meeting attendance and various other opportunities.
    NCS provides a yearly "Get Involved" campaign where NCS members can volunteer for service on NCS committees and other opportunities

# **Overview of the Pharmacy Section and Leadership**

- Overview:
  - The Pharmacy Section is comprised of neurocritical care pharmacists who collaborate and work together to further neurocritical care pharmacy, patient care, research and the neurocritical care pharmacy profession
- Pharmacy Section Leadership:
  - The Pharmacy Section Leadership Committee is comprised of 12-16 appointed members of the Pharmacy Section; the Pharmacy Section Leadership Committee Chair appoints members of the committee. Members of the Pharmacy Section Leadership Committee serve for a maximum of four years. The charge of the committee is to be responsible for growing, strengthening and diversifying the pharmacy voice within NCS. The committee oversees the functioning of the Pharmacy Section and the Pharmacotherapy of Neurocritical Care Series (PONS) committee in collaboration with other NCS entities

- Benefits of Pharmacy Section Membership and Opportunities for Involvement:
  - Networking and Collaboration
    - The Pharmacy Section and its members are very engaged within NCS and networking and collaboration are the hallmark benefits of the Pharmacy Section
      - NCS Annual Meeting:
        - At each annual meeting, a Pharmacy Section networking event is held and a Pharmacy Section business meeting is held to facilitate networking and collaboration
      - Pharmacy Section Website:
        - As a section of NCS, the Pharmacy Section has a website that contains a discussion board/email list-serve, library of resources and listing of members
        - The website can be used to collaborate with other Pharmacy Section members, share resources and post questions for input from colleagues
        - o Pharmacy Section website
  - Research collaboration
    - The Pharmacy Section has a Pharmacy Research/Scholarship Committee that aims to develop research questions for contemporary neurocritical care clinical problems and to execute well-designed studies to address these clinical problems. In addition, the committee aims to develop neurocritical care pharmacists as researchers
      - Opportunities exist to pose research questions for review and feedback, gain experience and mentorship in clinical research

and participate in the design and execution of clinical research studies

- To date, large studies on practice patterns in treatment of status epilepticus, treatment and prevention of hyponatremia, intraventricular antibiotics, and coagulopathy reversal have been published from our pharmacy group
- Pharmacy Section Journal Clubs
  - The Pharmacy Section organizes and facilitates an every-other month webbased journal club with pharmacy residents as the presenters
  - Opportunities are available to participate as a moderator or organizer
